

electrical tape




3V coin cell battery

Mix together the unknown particles gathered from Area 51 and the ghost residue with the plastic stir stick provided. Mix together the unknown particles gathered from




Fill up your bottle of questionable materials with Fill up your bottle of questionable materials with water. Make sure to fill it almost all the way to the top. It should be just about where the bottom of the lid is.




STEP 3

Pour your mixture from Step 1 into your jar of
questionable materials and water. What happens
here is pretty cool so watch closely!





Make your base for your jar! Insert the LED into the slot in the base. You can tape in place if you would like but it's not necessary.





Now it's time to connect the battery! Make sure the red wire is touching the positive side of the battery and the black wire is touching the negative side. Use the strip of electrical tape to secure the wires to the battery.

> With wire it's common practice to have red wire be the positive connection and black wire be the negative connection. This is also called power (positive) and ground (negative).

STEP

Time for the spooky part! With your batter secured, place your base on a flat surface, then place your jar on top of your base. The next thing is to turn off the lights (or move into a darker environment)!
